

## **MADER Wine Description**:

## Riesling Grand Cru Rosacker

Origine:

The Grand Cru Rosacker, situated on the north side of Hunawihr, is a south east facing slope on a deep limestone ground with high concentration of magnesium and silica. Due to his proximity with the mountain, it is a medium cold terroir (compare to other limestone Grand Cru terroir) that allow a long ripening season without botrytis.

All the vineyard is grow organically without any chemical. Certified by Ecocert since 2007.
