

BELONDRADE Y LURTON 2020

Classification: Aged white wine

Grape variety: 95% verdejo, 5% other varieties

Apellation: Rueda. Alc.: 14% vol. Organic: Yes

Viticulture and vinification: Wine produced exclusively from hand-harvested organic grapes from our Quinta San Diego estate. Our vineyard is a mosaic of 23 plots offering diverse soil compositions, planting patterns, exposures and ages of vines (8 to 50 years) with controlled yields of 38 hl/ha. Fermented spontaneously and aged on its lees in French oak barrels of different characteristics.

Climatic conditions: Both the temperatures and the precipitation registered during the agricultural year 2020 were notably higher than the records of previous years (with the exception of 2018). A mild especially rainy fall led to one of the warmest winters to date. Spring brought together the ideal conditions for budding, rain and a gradual temperatures to enter a warm summer in which the vineyard team had to fight against the spread of microorganisms. Thanks to the application of ecological treatments as to the removal of vegetation, a particularly healthy harvest was achieved. With the incorporation of a new sorting machine on the top of our "traditional" sorting table, the grape process was improved, obtaining musts with great balance and expression.
